## A Look Into Our Program

**Fiddle Fun – 2008** is a total immersion program for violin, viola and cello students of all ages and levels: beginners to advanced. Presented on the beautiful campus of the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma in Chickasha, this day camp will provide a fully integrated week of music and fine arts. Students will receive individual instruction, as well as both small and large group instruction, and will hear Yuval Waldman perform daily. Classes combining music with art and dance will be woven into instruction for young students through middle school age. ‘Fiddle Fun’ is directed by internationally know violinist, teacher, and conductor Yuval Waldman, assisted by Heather Bush, and Angela Kreiger.

**Yuval Waldman** has appeared as a solo violinist and conductor throughout the United States, Europe, Asia, and Africa, performing with such artists as Isaac Stern, Pinchas Zukerman, Jean-Pierre Rampal, Maureen Forrester, and Henrik Szerng. He was professor and head of the string department at the State University of New York and has given hundreds of workshops and master classes throughout the world. He is the founder and music director of numerous music festivals in the United States and Europe. Mr. Waldman is a frequent performer as a soloist and conductor with the St. Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra. In 2004 he was appointed Music Director of the International Music Competition “Tchaikovsky’s Homeland” in Votkinsk, (Tchaikovsky’s birthplace) Russia. Yuval Waldman is currently directing a series of music festivals called the “5 B’s” on the campus of USAO. Each festival, one each trimester, features a different composer: Bach, Beethoven, Brahms, Bartok and Bernstein. **Heather Bush**, a nationally board certified teacher since 2003, is director of the Overture String Orchestra and has had orchestras under her direction successfully perform and compete on local, regional and national levels. Mrs. Bush received her Bachelor of Music Education from the University of Central Oklahoma where she also obtained her post-graduate work in history. Heather taught for the Oklahoma City Public Schools for 10 years, spending nine years at Classen School of Advanced Studies. In 2005 Mrs. Bush began the Suzuki Violin and Viola program for Casady School in Oklahoma City. Mrs. Bush remains active as a performer (violin, viola), studio instructor and chamber music coach, and is the director of the Oklahoma City Summer Strings Camp.

**Angela Krieger**, cellist, is the Elementary Music Teacher in Rush Springs, OK. Mrs. Krieger holds a Bachelor’s degree in cello performance and a Master’s degree in Music Education from Southwestern Oklahoma State University in Weatherford, OK. Mrs. Krieger frequently performs professionally with the Southwestern String Quintet. In the summer of 2008, she will be completing her Level I Certification in Orff Schulwerk method of teaching music. Mrs. Krieger is also the newsletter editor for the Central Oklahoma Orff Chapter and a member of the American Orff Schulwerk Association.
