## UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA BOARD OF REGENTS MINUTES June 8, 2023

The Board of Regents for the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma met Wednesday, June 7, 2023, in the Student Center Regents' Room on the Science and Arts of Oklahoma campus. Chair Mosley called the meeting to order at 8:04 a.m. and asked for roll call. Members present – Chris Mosley, Diane Ming, Cale Walker, and David McLaughlin. Members absent – Kelly Wilkerson, David Ferrell, and JJ Francais. Also present were Diane Carroll, Executive Assistant to the President and Secretary to the Science and Arts Board of Regents.

- 1. Executive session Chair Mosley read: Consideration of a motion and vote to enter Executive Session pursuant to 25 O.S. §307 (b)(1) for the purpose of discussing the employment (including interviewing Candidates, evaluating Candidates, and compensation) for the position of President of the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma.

    - c. Discussion to change President Feaver's status to President Emeritus effective the same day as new president's start date
