**POSITION SUMMARY:** The School of Arts and Humanities at the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor of Film & Media, who will also serve as Film & Media Program Coordinator. This interdisciplinary position supports Art, Communication, and Marketing and is designed to prepare students for creative and commercial careers in the film and media industries.

The successful candidate will be a well-rounded scholar-practitioner with hands-on experience across the full filmmaking process, including development, production, post-production, and distribution. The candidate should be able to teach film as both an artistic practice and an industry.

### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach a 4/4 undergraduate load or a combination of teaching and coordination duties.
- Advise students and supervise undergraduate film and media productions.
- Serve as Film & Media Program Coordinator, providing academic leadership and managing daily program operations.
- Collaborate with the Dean and faculty in Art, Communication, and Marketing to maintain an industry-relevant curriculum.
- Lead curriculum development, assessment, scheduling, facilities, and equipment planning.
- Support internships, guest speakers, workshops, and industry partnerships.
- Mentor students through capstone projects, demo reels, and professional portfolios.
- Engage in creative and/or scholarly activity and participate in university service.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

- MA, MFA, or PhD in Film, Media, Communication, or a related field is required.
- 2–5 years of relevant professional and/or teaching experience

- Demonstrated experience across multiple areas of filmmaking, including production and post-production
- Proficiency with industry-standard tools such as Adobe Premiere, DaVinci Resolve, or comparable software
- Ability to manage film and video equipment and instructional resources
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
