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### C. Technical Skill:

- Did the actors maintain a physicality that maintained open, appropriate sightlines?
- Did the actors make clear choices about the physicality of the character?
- Did the actors demonstrate control of their voices (resonance, projection & articulation)?
- Did the actors make vocal choices that helped to convey their characters?

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## **D.** Focus and Discipline:

- Did the actors demonstrate the willingness and ability to work with their partner?
- Did the actors have a clear, prepared "slate" for the scene?
- Did the actors demonstrate control and confidence in the scene?
- Did the actors project "performance quality" energy?

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# E. Overall Effect:

- Were the tone, style, and mood of the scene appropriate to the story?
