5 6	A Resolution Urging the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma Administration to Permit Students and Staff to Attend Outdoor Sporting Events Under Necessary Guidance
7	Termit Students and Staff to Attend Outdoor Sporting Events Under Necessary Guidance
8	WHEREAS: USAO has successfully mitigated the spread of Covid-19 through a series of
9	changes and regulations designed to keep students safe. These changes, which have been
10	objectively effective in keeping students safe still allow for students to gather in
11	classrooms, hold in-person meetings, visit dorms and apartments so long as they live in
12	the same residence, and even eat maskless in the cafeteria, all of which present a higher
13	risk to the health of students in this pandemic than attending outdoor sporting events.
14	
15	WHEREAS: The isolation forced onto students, however necessary, has caused a severe
16	mental health crisis nationwide. Young adults kept in isolation have been found to have
17	joined dangerous online communities, engage in unhealthy social behaviors, and develop
18	worse eating habits as a result of declining mental health. Though students shouldn't be
19	able to sit close together, attending a sporting event, given the opportunity provides some
20	sort of escape from torturous monotony and deters students from engaging in behaviors
21	detrimental to an already-declining mental health.
2223	WHEREAS: The natural ventilation and constant redistribution of air outdoors makes it a
24	significantly safer space than some of those which students are currently allowed to
25	occupy indoors which, given the University's success is containing Covid-19, indicates
26	that USAO students have consistently taken the initiative to keep their fellow students
27	and professors safe and will likely continue to do so with continued guidance and
28	restrictions.

30	WHEREAS: Ticket sales from outdoor sporting events have the potential to increase revenue
31	for the University, increasing their means to obtain supplies such as masks to keep us
32	safe, provide tools to help students cope with the stress brought about by the last year, or
33	to simply help the University financially.

35	NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION 19
36	SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA THAT:

38	SECTION 1: Students and staff be permitted to, given that they've purchased a valid ticket,
39	attend university sporting events that are played outdoors so long as they follow mask
40	mandates and social distancing guidelines determined by USAO administration.
